Attending diabetes camp improves self-management skills, diabetes education and blood sugar control. It is also one of the best ways for children to meet other kids their age with diabetes.

Campers have the opportunity to hang out with kids their own age, learn about diabetes from certified diabetes educators, enjoy a variety of typical camp activities and gain confidence and independence in their ability to manage their diabetes. Did we mention swimming and creating cool projects?

Our 2024 theme is “#ThatsGold,” coinciding with the 2024 Summer Olympics. We will incorporate this theme into our daily activities that include crafts, cooking and education.

Qualified camp team

A medical director is on call at all times during camp. Our camp team also includes nurses, activity coordinators and certified diabetes educators.
